¹ The former Yugoslavia had previously ratified CERD on 2 October 1967, CCPR on 2 June 1971, CESC on 2 June 1971, CEDAW on 26 February 1982, CAT on 10 September 1991 and CRC on 3 January 1991. Subsequent to the dissolution of the former Yugoslavia, the Government of Croatia

deposited with the Secretary-General notifications of succession to these treaties, with effect from 8 October 1991, the date on which Croatia became an independent state.

² In its concluding observations adopted in May 2004, the Committee Against Torture recommended that the State party submit a combined fourth and fifth periodic report on 7 October 2008.
