<sup>1</sup> The former Yugoslavia had previously ratified CERD on 2 October 1967, CCPR on 2 June 1971, CDESCR on 2 June 1971, CEDAW on 26 February 1982, CAT on 10 September 1991 and CRC on 3 January 1991. Slovenia had declared its independence from the Former Yugoslavia on 25 June 1991. Subsequently, the Government of Slovenia deposited with the Secretary-General on 1 July 1992
