¹ The former Yugoslavia had previously ratified CERD on 2 October 1967, CCPR on 2 June 1971, CESCRC on 2 June 1971, CEDAW on 26 February 1982, CAT on 10 September 1991 and CRC on 3 January 1991. Slovenia had declared its independence from the Former Yugoslavia on 25 June 1991. Subsequently, the Government of Slovenia deposited with the Secretary-General on 1 July 1992 notifications of succession to these treaties.

² In its concluding observations adopted on 25 July 2005, the Human Rights Committee requested that the State party provide additional information within one year, and requested that the third periodic report be submitted by 1 August 2010.
