PROVISIONAL AGENDA AND ANNOTATIONS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The eighty-second session of the Human Rights Committee will be held at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 18 October to 5 November 2004. The first meeting will be convened at the United Nations Office at Geneva, Palais Wilson, Ground Floor Conference Room on Monday, 18 October 2004 at 10 a.m.
2. In accordance with rule 6 of the Committee's rules of procedure, the Secretary-General has prepared, in consultation with the Chairperson of the Committee, the attached provisional agenda for the eighty-second session. Annotations to the provisional agenda are also attached.
3. Pursuant to rule 33 of the Committee's rules of procedure, the meetings of the Committee will be held in public unless the Committee decides otherwise or it appears from the relevant provisions of the Covenant or the Optional Protocol that the meetings should be held in private.
4. The attention of States parties is drawn, in particular, to the annotations to item 6, which contains the tentative timetable for the consideration of reports during the eighty-second session. In accordance with rule 68 of the Committee's rules of procedure, representatives of States parties are expected to be present at the meetings of the Committee when their reports are examined.
5. As established under rule 95 of its rules of procedure, a working group should meet for a period of one week prior to its eighty-second session. The pre-sessional working group will meet from 18 October to 5 November 2004.

ANNOTATIONS

1. Opening of the session by the High Commissioner for Human Rights

The High Commissioner for Human Rights or her representative will open the eighty-second session of the Committee.

2. Adoption of the agenda

Under rule 8 of the Committee's rules of procedure, the first item on the agenda for any session shall be the adoption of the agenda. In accordance with rule 9, the Committee may revise the agenda during a session and may, as appropriate, defer or delete items.

3. Organizational and other matters

Under this item, the Committee will consider miscellaneous issues relevant to the Committee's business.

4. Meeting with representatives of non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations

At its eightieth session, the Committee decided to hear representatives of non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations represented at the United Nations Office at Geneva. The meeting has accordingly been scheduled for Monday, 18 October 2004, from 10.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

5. Submission of reports by States parties under article 40 of the Covenant

A. Reports received

Apart from the reports which are scheduled for consideration by the Committee at its eighty-second session (see the timetable for consideration of reports under item 6 below), the Secretary-General has received the initial report of Greece, Thailand and Tajikistan; the second

periodic reports of Uzbekistan, Slovenia and Kenya; the third periodic report of the Syrian Arab Republic; the fourth periodic reports of Iceland and Yemen; and the fifth periodic report of Italy.

B. Reports due

For the situation with regard to the submission of reports by States parties under article 40 of the Covenant, reference is made to chapter III and annex IV of the Committee's annual report to the General Assembly for 2004 (see A/59/40, vol. I).

6. Consideration of reports submitted by States parties under article 40 of the Covenant

A tentative timetable for the consideration of reports at the eighty-second session, prepared in consultation with the Committee, is given below:

In accordance with rule 68 of the Committee's rules of procedure, the Secretary-General has informed the States parties concerned of the dates on which their respective reports are scheduled for consideration by the Committee at its eighty-second session.

The reports to be considered during the eighty-second session are those of Albania, Benin, Finland, Morocco and Poland.

7. Follow-up to concluding observations and to Views under the Optional Protocol

At its seventy-fourth session, the Committee adopted decisions governing the procedure for following up on concluding observations. During the seventy-fifth session, a Special Rapporteur for follow-up on concluding observations was appointed; he will provide his seventh progress report on his activities during the eighty-second session.

8. Third informal meeting with States parties to the Covenant

The third informal meeting with States parties to the Covenant will be held on Thursday, 28 October 2004, from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. in Conference Room XII of the Palais des Nations, United Nations Office at Geneva.

9. Consideration of communications under the Optional Protocol to the Covenant

In accordance with the provisions of chapter XVII of the rules of procedure, the Committee will consider under this item communications which are or appear to be submitted to it under the Optional Protocol.

Two hundred and ninety-three communications are pending before the Committee as of 27 September 2004. Pursuant to the Committee's new rules of procedure allowing the joint examination of admissibility and merits in most cases, the Committee's examination of these communications may result in the adoption of Views, or in decisions declaring the communications admissible or inadmissible.

In accordance with article 5, paragraph 3, of the Optional Protocol and rule 88 of the Committee's rules of procedure, this agenda item will be considered in closed meetings.
