Meeting of States Parties Twenty-eighth Meeting New York 9 November 2009

Election, in accordance with articles 28 to 34 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, of one member of the Human Rights Committee to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Mr. Mohammed Ayat (Morocco) whose term was to expire on 31 December 2012

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In conformity with article 34 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Twenty-eighth Meeting of States Parties to the Covenant will be convened by the Secretary-General at United Nations Headquarters on 9 November 2009, for the purpose of filling one vacancy in the Human Rights Committee.
- 2. In a letter dated 12 August 2009, Mr. Mohammed Ayat (Morocco), who was elected at the Twenty-seventh Meeting of States Parties to the Covenant held on 4 September 2008 for a term that was to expire on 31 December 2012, submitted his resignation from the Committee with immediate effect. In a letter dated 27 August 2009, the Chairperson of the Human Rights Committee informed the Secretary-General accordingly.
- 3. Pursuant to article 33, paragraph 2, and article 34, paragraph 1, of the Covenant, the Secretary-General declared the seat of Mr. Ayat vacant from the date of his resignation. By note verbale of 8 September 2009, the States parties to the Covenant were invited to submit nominations, by 8 November 2009, for the purpose of filling the vacancy for a term expiring on 31 December 2012.
- 4. The curriculum vitae of Mr. Mahjoub El Haiba, nominated by Morocco, is contained in the annex to the present document.
