1. Opening of the session

The representative of the Secretary-General will open the eleventh session of the Committee.

2. Adoption of the agenda

Under rule 6 of the Committee's provisional rules of procedure, the first item on the agenda of any session shall be the adoption of the agenda, unless the election of officers is required under rule 12. In accordance with rule 7, the Committee may revise the agenda during a session and may, as appropriate, defer or delete items.

3. Consideration of reports submitted by States parties under article 73 of the Convention

At its eleventh session, the Committee will consider the initial report received from Sri Lanka (CMW/C/LKA/1). The Secretary-General has informed the State party concerned that its report is scheduled for consideration by the Committee on Monday 12 October in the afternoon, and on Tuesday 13 October in the morning.
