## Annotations

### 1. Opening of the session

The representative of the Secretary-General will open the thirteenth session of the Committee.

### 2. Adoption of the agenda

Under rule 6 of the Committee's provisional rules of procedure, the first item on the agenda of any session shall be the adoption of the agenda, unless the election of officers is required under rule 12. In accordance with rule 7, the Committee may revise the agenda during a session and may, as appropriate, defer or delete items.

### 3. Consideration of reports submitted by States parties under article 73 of the Convention

At its thirteenth session, the Committee will consider the initial reports received from Albania (CMW/C/ALB/1) and Senegal (CMW/C/SEN/1) and the second periodic report received from Ecuador (CMW/C/ECU/2).

Under this item, the Committee will discuss its involvement in and support for various events to celebrate the twentieth anniversary of the adoption of the Convention.

## **6. Celebration of the twentieth anniversary of the adoption of the Convention.**

At its twelfth session, the Committee decided to organize jointly with the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights an open-ended one-day meeting in Geneva during its thirteenth session, to which States parties, civil society organizations and other partners would be invited to share experiences and views as to how the Convention has made a difference in shaping migration policy and practice. The meeting will take place on Monday, 29 November 2010.

## **7. Issues pertaining to the Convention**

Under this item, the Committee will continue discussions commenced at its twelfth session on a general comment on migrant domestic workers, following its day of general discussion held on this topic at its eleventh session.

## **8. Organizational and other matters**

Under this item, the Committee will consider miscellaneous issues relevant to the Committee's business, including its programme of work, dates for the future sessions of the Committee, methods of work of the Committee, and harmonization of treaty body working methods and other issues arising out of the 22nd Meeting of Chairpersons and 11th Inter-Committee, held in June 2010. The Committee will have before it the reports of those meetings.
