⁴ Effective 1 July 1997 and 20 December 1999 respectively, Hong Kong and Macau became special administrative regions of China. Previously, Hong Kong had been administered by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (which had ratified both CCPR and CESCROPT on 19 May 1976), and Macau had been administered by Portugal (which had ratified CCPR on 14 June 1978 and CESCROPT on 30 July 1978). In official notifications to the Secretary-General dated 20 June 1997 and 2 December 1999 respectively, the People=s Republic of China advised that the CCPR and the CESCROPT would continue to be applicable to the territories of Hong Kong and Macau.
