<sup>3</sup> In its concluding observations adopted on 24 March 2006, the Human Rights Committee requested that the State party submit additional information within one year, and that it submit its next periodic report by 1 April 2009.

<sup>4</sup> The Human Rights Committee decided to schedule consultations with the State party (see A/62/40 vol. I, page 142). In December 2008, the Special Rapporteur requested that the State party include the outstanding information in its fourth periodic report. The follow-up procedure with the Special Rapporteur is now terminated (see A/64/40, vol. I, page 179).
