The above dates of ratification of CERD, CCPR, CESCR, CEDAW, CAT, denote the date of ratification of the Federal Republic of Germany, in accordance with its notification of 3 October 1990. The German Democratic Republic had ratified CERD on 23 March 1973, CCPR on 8 November 1973, CESCR on 8 November 1973, CEDAW on 9 July 1980 and CAT on 9 September 1987.
